The Midtown Residents Association Emergency Preparedness Committee has established a "Block Preparedness Coordinator" program. I have volunteered to be one of the Block Preparedness Coordinators (BPC) for our block.

Each Block Preparedness Coordinator (BPC) receives training as well as civic and community information and works with the Midtown Residents Association Emergency Preparedness Committee Chair, Annette Ashton. The information (announcements, meetings, etc.) will be related to our safety (as in the "Neighborhood Watch" program) and to our survival in the event of a catastrophic event (such as, earthquake, pandemic flu, chemical spill, or even a prolonged power outage). The goal of the program is for our neighborhood to become self-reliant. This can be fun too, with social events such as block parties and sharing good news among neighbors.
